Food & Cooking

We believe in family. Food is provided in your weekly suggested donation and we eat dinner together. You will be invited to participate in a roster to serve the community through assisting the designated chefs. We provide vegetarian and animal protein options in our weekly menu's. We typically serve 3 vegetarian meals and 4 animal protein meals per week. We source only organic or grass fed, hormone free animal protein.

Water & Cleaning

Water is sacred and to be managed with great care and efficiency. We use rainwater and provide filtered drinking water. We re-use water for washing dishes. Please become proficient is the community's housekeeping processes. We only use grey water safe soaps or detergents.

Rubbish & Composting

We work hard to avoid modern wasteful practices that are detrimental to the environment. Avoid single use plastic packaging when purchasing community and individual items.
